As you are well aware, this year marks the centenary of the Armistice and, as Parish Councillor at St Wenn, I have been instrumental in arranging a commemorative event from Thursday 8th – Sunday 11th November. ‘St Wenn Remembers’ will be an opportunity for people to come and participate in any of the functions where, I hope, there will be something for everyone!

We have a full programme including a Flower Festival and Exhibition in the Church on Friday and Saturday from 10.30am – 4.30pm and Sunday following our Remembrance service until 4.30pm. Floral arrangements will depict the various aspects of WW1 and an exhibition will showcase the research, undertaken locally, of the 44 men who served, of which 38 survived. Other events include a cinema night, blighty breakfast, Edwardian themed pub night and two concerts, for which ticket entry will apply.
